**City of Bel-Nor - PROPOSITION 1**

Shall the City of Bel-Nor be authorized to impose a business license tax on utilities including companies supplying light, electricity, power, gas, telephone and water, in the amount of six percent for customers within the City?

**City of Bellefontaine Neighbors - Bond Election - PROPOSITION S**

Shall the City of Bellefontaine Neighbors, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$8,000,000 for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, extending, repairing and improving the surface and subsurface conditions affecting city streets and sidewalks, and acquiring any land necessary therefor?

**City of Dellwood - PROPOSITION A**

Shall the City of Dellwood, Missouri assess and collect a semi-annual registration fee of \$200.00 for any vacant residential property that has been or will be vacant for a period of 6 months as well as a forty-five dollar (\$45.00) inspection fee for any subsequent inspection(s) of the aforesaid property?

**City of Ferguson - PROPOSITION U**

Shall the City of Ferguson be authorized to increase the current business license tax on utilities, including companies supplying light, electricity, power, gas, telephone and water, by two percent which will result in a total business license tax on utilities in the amount of eight percent?

**City of Glendale - Bond Election - PROPOSITION S**

Shall the City of Glendale, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in an amount up to Eight Million Dollars for the purpose of constructing, furnishing and equipping a new fire station and acquiring land necessary therefor and renovating, improving, furnishing and equipping the existing city hall complex?

**City of Glendale - PROPOSITION F**

Shall the City of Glendale, Missouri, impose a sales tax of one quarter of one percent for the purpose of providing revenue for the operation of the Glendale Fire Department, including the acquisition and maintenance of a fire pumper truck?

**City of Greendale - Mayor - unexpired term ending April 2019**

**City of Pasadena Hills - PROPOSITION P**

Shall the City of Pasadena Hills increase the tax rate for residential real property in the amount of \$.59 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation to fund policing and public safety? Said tax increase shall be effective immediately and reflected in the October 2016 taxation rate. If this proposition is approved, the total adjusted residential tax levy is estimated to be \$1.78 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

**City of Rock Hill - PROPOSITION V**

Shall the City of Rock Hill, Missouri continue applying and collecting the local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchases from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer? Rejection of this measure will result in a reduction of local revenue to provide for vital services for the City of Rock Hill, Missouri and it will place Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats, and trailers at a competitive disadvantage to non-Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats, and trailers.

**City of Velda City - PROPOSITION B**

Shall the City of Velda City, Missouri continue applying and collecting the local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer? Rejection of this measure will result in reduction of local revenue to provide for vital services for the City of Velda City, Missouri and will place the Missouri dealer of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats, and trailers at a competitive disadvantage to non-Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats, and trailers.

**City of Velda Village Hills - PROPOSITION A**

Shall the City of Velda Village Hills, Missouri continue applying and collecting the local sales tax on the titling of motor vehicles, trailers, boats, and outboard motors that were purchased from a source other than a licensed Missouri dealer? Rejection of this measure will result in a reduction of local revenue to provide for vital services for the City of Velda Village Hills, Missouri and it will place Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats, and trailers at a competitive disadvantage to non-Missouri dealers of motor vehicles, outboard motors, boats and trailers.

**City of Velda Village Hills - PROPOSITION B**

Shall the City of Velda Village Hills, Missouri impose a sales tax of one half of one percent on all retail sales made in the City of Velda Village Hills for the purpose of providing funding for storm water control and local parks for the municipality?
